

Home winemaker turned pro

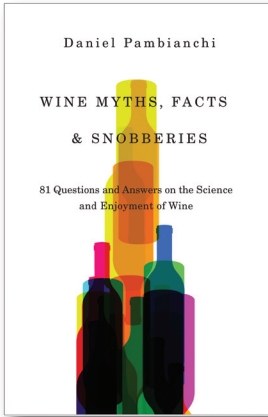
DANIEL PAMBIANCHI

We raise a glass of wine to Daniel and to all those who have made better wine because of him. Salute!

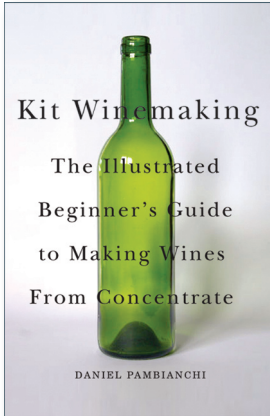

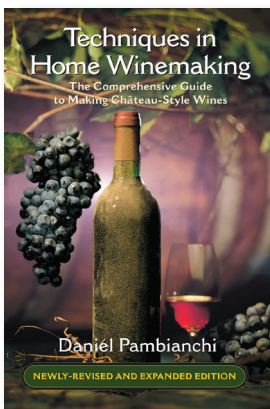
